

## Shepaug Soccer Club—Fall 2016 Registration

REGISTRATION for the Shepaug Soccer Club's Fall 2016 programs will begin on June 1st through July 15th. There will be a late registration period from July 16 – July 31 if space allows that will cost an additional \$25 per player for the Travel program only (U8 - U12). Both U5 & U6 Dinomites programs will continue with registration right through until September or when program fills.

The Fall soccer season will begin on Saturday, September 10th and run through Saturday, November 20th. The travel programs will have 1-2 practices per week beginning the week of August 29 and then have 8 games, Saturday or Sunday depending what division the teams are in through November 20th. The Dinomites program will run from September 17 - October 29. Times for these programs are TBD but will be at Hurlburt Park in Roxbury. The U8 pre-travel program is co-ed and is part of the Northwest Recreation League. Games will be played in assorted towns on Saturday mornings and 1-2 practices will be held during the week.
