RULES FOR RESIDENTS

ALL Materials deposited at the transfer station must originate within the Town of Roxbury and be from residential properties. Let the Operator know if you know someone from out of town is using our Transfer Station.

Permits are required on all vehicles. Permits must be affixed on the lower driver's side portion of the windshield. If it is not so placed, the driver will be denied use of the Transfer Station.

The following are NOT accepted:

- Grass (lawn) clippings/leaves
- Tree stumps or logs/stone
- Hazardous Waste
- Septic Waste
- Materials that have not been prepared for collection, collected or transported in accordance with the Town's Ordinance.

Permits can be purchased at the Transfer Station by CHECK only.


BULKY WASTE

Residential Bulky Waste Only

No Commercial Bulky Allowed
(Excludes home-based Businesses)

Bulky Waste Disposal Fees

- \$30 – Refrigerator / Freezer
- \$10 – Air Conditioner or Dehumidifier
- \$20 – Mattress
- \$25 – Pick-up Loads



Also Accepted with No Cost

Windows/Mirror Glass, Ceramic Plates, Pyrex Crystal, Rubber, Plastic,
Metallic components



ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

HOW TO PREPARE MATERIALS

NOT ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

NEWSPAPERS

(the following materials can be added to your bundled, clean newspapers)



Clean, Mixed Paper, Junk mail, magazines, printer paper, catalogs, coupons, newspaper supplements, paper envelopes, boxboard, shoe boxes, cereal boxes, pasta boxes, shredded paper

Place in a brown paper bag, or tie them in a bundle with cotton or fiber twine.

Remove plastic and wax-paper liners from all items, flatten boxes

Soiled paper
Plastic-coated paper
Cellophane
Wet newspapers
Books



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Clean, Dry corrugated cardboard (waffle middle) that has no plastic or waxed surface

Flatten or cut into small sections and bundle with cotton or fiber twine
KEEP CLEAN & DRY

Waxed non corrugated or wet cardboard

GLASS, STEEL, ALUMINUM OR PLASTIC CANS, JARS, BOTTLES OR ALUMINUM FOOD TRAYS

Food and beverage containers, aluminum foil, poly-coated milk/juice cartons
PLEASE SEPARATE 5¢ RETURNABLES

Washed & Clean
Attached Labels and Clean Lids
Acceptable



Dishes
Light Bulbs
Window/Mirror Glass
Aluminum Siding
Spray & Aerosol Cans



PLASTICS



Plastics #1-#7 (except black plastics or anything larger than 2.5 gallons)

Washed & Clean
Attached Labels OK

Motor Oil Containers

BATTERIES

Batteries from Autos, Tractors & Trucks

Leave caps on storage battery
GIVE TO OPERATOR

Dry Cell Batteries D, AA, AAA, etc.
(Put in garbage)


WASTE OIL/ANTIFREEZE

Waste Oil/Antifreeze drained from engines

Separate & Operator will pour into tanks

Do not mix with other liquids

SCRAP METAL



Metal items, ask Operator if you are not sure about an item

Deposit into dumpster marked METAL

Rubber, Plastic or other metallic components

E-RECYCLE

ALL ELECTRONICS
TV's, computers, monitors

Place inside marked roofed container

Ask Operator if unsure about an item

CELL PHONES FOR SOLDIERS

Collection Bin in Town Hall

CLOTHING DONATIONS

Bring Clean, used clothing to marked collection bins.

Make room in your closet and help someone in need

HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE



- Deposit in Compactor
- **MUST BE IN PLASTIC BAGS**
- Includes materials listed as "Not Acceptable" for recycling unless noted as Bulky Waste

ROXBURY RESIDENT RELIEF

Donate your 5¢ returnable cans & bottles to help with resident relief efforts. Deposit into marked containers

HAZARDOUS WASTE DAYS

Wood Preservatives / Oil Based Paint
Pesticides
Fluorescent Light Bulbs / Pool Chemicals
